Recreating screens	<p>In earlier releases, recreating a panel for an existing Smart Build panel, did not recreate the screen.</p> <p>To improve the user experience, an option is provided to recreate the screen when the user is prompted to recreate a panel during Smart Build, making the panel and screen in sync.</p>

What's fixed

What's fixed describes resolutions to problems that were found in a previous release.

Issue	Description	Component
LS-26306	After using a PCCommand from the IBM host together with the setting <code>PcOForceBlankScreenOnExecute=1</code> , sometimes the client stopped responding until the PC command execution window was manually closed. This issue has been fixed.	Windows client
LS-26629	Using a lasso copy on a panel and pasting this as a (DDE) link in Microsoft Word, did not work correctly. This issue has been fixed.	Windows client
LS-26807	Sharing the collection flow file (<code>collection.sts</code>) using a Lifecycle Manager repository caused a stack overflow when collecting display files in the Host Picture Builder. This issue has been fixed.	Workbench
LS-26998	An Auto-Detect DBCS entry field incorrectly shortened a character from entered DBCS input. This issue has been fixed.	Windows client
LS-27302	In versions 8.5.4 and 8.5.5, scrollbars in pop-ups, for example, in a calendar, appeared unexpectedly when using panel and font resizing. This issue has been fixed.	Windows client
LS-27328	Compared to Windows live test or in the Windows client, running a GUI live test on a panel with menus did not show the menus, which was incorrect in LegaSuite GUI 8.5.5. This issue has been fixed.	Workbench
